## Giving to charity through Gift Aid

Gift Aid increases the value of donations to charities by allowing us to reclaim basic rate tax on your membership fee.

### How Gift Aid works

The Gift Aid scheme is for gifts of money by individuals who pay UK tax. Gift Aid donations are regarded as having basic rate tax deducted by the donor. Nantwich Players will reclaim the basic rate tax on the membership fee from HMRC.

Your membership fee of £25 is worth £31.25 to Nantwich Players after gift-aid.

In certain circumstances, you may need to tell HMRC about Gift-Aid donations you have made, for instance if you fill in a tax return, so please make a note.

### How to make your membership for Nantwich Players a donation using Gift Aid

In order to make a Gift Aid donation you'll need to make a Gift Aid declaration, which is done by filling in the membership form overleaf and ticking the Gift-Aid box.

Nantwich Players will send this to HMRC on your behalf. HMRC will then anonymously pay the additional gift-aid income to Nantwich Players.
